

Los Alamos Camp Ground Rules

Be aware and alert!: There are bears, snakes, coyotes, bobcats, rabbits, etc. roaming the area. Don't leave food out for them.

- Fees are due at check-in. Check out time is 12:00pm. If additional time is needed, please see your camp host.
- Your fee is for 6 people and 2 vehicles. The maximum capacity of each site is 10 people, however there is a \$5.00 nightly fee for each person over the 6 included in the site fee.
- Additional vehicles are \$10.00 per night
- The speed limit is 10pmh. Vehicles and bicycles must stay on the pavement at all times. Follow all directional signs.
- Small fires may be built. DO NOT LEAVE FIRES UNATTENDED. Wood must not extend out of the fire-ring. No fires allowed during high winds. Let your fire die out or use small amounts of water and stir. Don't use the soil to extinguish. Use only grills or steel fire rings provided and do not relocate them. No rock fire-rings. If you use charcoal BBQ, it should be in a ring.
- Do not chop, cut, or mutilate the trees or break the branches. Do not remove tree stakes.
- Make sure all faucets are off after using.
- No excessive noise. No amplified music. Quiet hours are 10:00pm – 6:00am. Be respectful of your fellow campers.
- No gray or black water dumping except into a self-contained receptacle. There is a dump area available for RVs.
- Water faucets must only be used to fill containers for campsite use. No fish cleaning, washing of clothes, hair, cooking or eating utensils, or teeth brushing at water or pumps.
- No permanent water hookups. Fill RV and disconnect hose.
- No unlicensed drivers or vehicles.
- No disposing of trash or plastic bags in toilets or fire-rings. Use the dumpster when possible.
- No firing of firearms, air guns, bow and arrows, or other projectile firing devices and fireworks.
- No horses or livestock in campground.
- No cutting, mutilating, carving or driving nails into live vegetation, tables, or restrooms.
- No parking or camping in non-designated areas or other campsites.
- No unleashed or unattended pets. Pick up and deposit all pet droppings in the trash.
- No unsupervised children
- Do not litter. Dispose of trash and cigarettes properly.
- Stake down your tent. The campground is prone to high winds at times.
