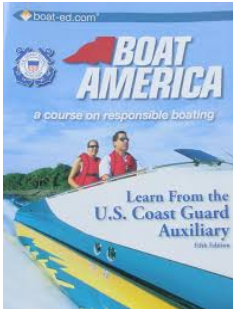




Public Education Course Flyer: Boat America
