

SLIP RENTALS

Lake Cachuma Marina offers wet slip storage units for boats. Slips run from \$15.00 per night, \$90.00 per week and \$125.00 per month. Monthly slips require a 3-month minimum. Current available slips are limited so don't wait! Contact the bait shop to inquire about slips still available for rent.

DIRECTIONS

From the South: Take Highway 101 north to Santa Barbara. Take the "Cachuma Lake/Highway 154" exit and follow the signs. Drive approximately 18 miles. There is a sign for the park ½ mile before the entrance, and there is a right turn lane to use for your safety.

From the North: Take Highway 101 south to the "Cachuma Lake/Highway 154" exit. Make a left at the stop sign and drive approximately 14 miles. There is a sign 1/4 mile before the park entrance, and there is a left turn lane to use for your safety.

BOAT RENTALS

Located off Highway 154 in the Los Padres National Forest, Lake Cachuma is positioned midway between the beaches of Santa Barbara and the community of Solvang.

FISHING AT LAKE CACHUMA

Lake Cachuma is one of Southern California's best fishing lakes because of the lake-bottom of rocky drop-offs, shallow areas, and aquatic plant bed, a great habitat for different kinds of fish. The lake is stocked annually with rainbow trout ranging in size from 1-7 lbs. During normal (non-drought) years, it supports large populations of largemouth and small mouth bass, crappie, bluegill, red-ear sunfish, channel catfish, and rainbow trout. This contributes to the popularity of annual fishing derbies at this lake facility.

A boat launch and docking facility for private sail and motorboats sits bordering the Marina.

Fishing licenses are required for those ages 16 and up and can be purchased at the Marina.

No Swimming

Dogs are *now* allowed to join boaters and fisherman on the Lake, for a small fee. Body contact is still prohibited though, so please make sure all dogs stay out of the water. This also includes swimming, water-skiing, windsurfing or any other body contact. Call (805) 688-4040 for fishing conditions.

A variety of boats are available for rent all year round however, boat selection may vary in the winter months. All boats are rented on a first-come first-served basis, with the exception of the annual trout derby.

BOATING REGULATIONS

Boating is available every day of the year, weather permitting, except Christmas day. Please comply with all State boating regulations and do not enter any restricted areas indicated on the lake map. Kayaks are allowed in Santa Cruz Bay, and The Narrows.

STANDARD-DESIGNED BOAT MINIMUMS

- 10 ft. long, 42 in. wide and 12 in. deep in the passenger carrying space
- Inflatables must have rigid flooring, a rigid transom, and 2 or more inflatable chambers.
- Boats under 12 ft. long and 48 in. wide may carry no more than 2 persons.
- Collapsibles must be at least 12 ft. in length, bow to stern, may not carry more than 2 persons, and may not carry a motor weighing more than 50 lbs. All collapsibles must display a Coast Guard certificate for design and manufacturer.
- Catamarans with trampoline decks must be at least 14 ft. in length and may carry a maximum 4 persons.
